

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 5:27-32. What strikes you as you read?
2. Have you ever felt that Jesus has led you INTO a storm, or ALLOWED a storm to hit that you were unprepared to face? How does that challenge our typical understanding of faith in Jesus? How did he demonstrate his presence with you in the midst of that storm? How did it all turn out? How do you interpret that storm now?
3. When trials have come, have you ever felt like God was "asleep?" What did you do to try & "wake him up?" How did that work for you? What did you discover?
4. Jesus said "Let's cross the lake." Since Jesus is always true to his word, how could faith have changed the way the disciples reacted in the midst of the storm? How does being able to claim a specific promise or a specific command from Jesus alter the way you approach a difficult (or an easy) situation?
5. What is the difference between believing in spite of circumstances, & obeying in spite of feelings & appearances? Which are you most likely to do? Why?
6. What from this week can you share with someone who doesn't yet trust in Jesus?
