

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 24:1-12. What do you notice? Does your familiarity with this text hamper you hearing it fresh today? Do you ever tire of this announcement? Why?
2. How would you answer someone who asked; "Why is Easter such a big deal?"
3. Why do the women go to the tomb? It's the third day...what are they expecting? Why? Why do we expect the "old life" to persist even though Jesus promises new?
4. Since there were no eyewitnesses to the actual resurrection, what sorts of evidence would you point to as proof of Jesus' being raised from the dead?
5. Why is it not enough that Christ came, lived as a kind good man, performed miracles, & taught with wisdom? How would you explain to a non-Christian the importance of the resurrection? What impact does Christ's resurrection have on how you face life?
6. Read Romans 6:1-11. What blessings are yours now that Jesus is raised from the dead? In what ways could the resurrection of Jesus be a source of renewal & hope for you on a daily basis? How can you share that with someone who doesn't believe?
7. Read the "resurrection" verses each day & pick one that speaks powerfully to you.
