

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Revelation 5:1-14 & 2:12-17. What do you notice? What questions immediately come to mind?
2. What do you think makes the scroll so significant? Why is it important to find someone "worthy" to open it & declare its contents? Why is that person only Jesus?
3. What do the titles used to describe Jesus indicate? How does his position in this vision, & the role he carries out mean for your life?
4. Compare the songs sung to the Lamb in verses 9, 10, 12, & 13 to the praise spoken to God the Father in 4:8 & 4:11. How are they similar? How are they different?
5. Why does John indicate this (v 9) is a "new song"? What's "new" here? What does that mean for you? What does it call you to do from now on? How are you going to be obedient to that call?
6. Consider the awe-inspiring spiritually overwhelming experience of John that you will one day have also. Who do you know who is going to miss out on that joy if you don't share the good news of Jesus with them?
