

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Revelation 10:1-11 & 11:15-19. What do you notice? What questions immediately come to mind?
2. What's the difference between a spectator and a participant? Under what circumstances would you prefer to be one or the other? Why?
3. What's the most difficult part of living your faith among those who don't share your trust in Jesus? When have you had to accept not knowing an answer to some situation in your life? How is the on-going mystery of the end of human history a problem for you sometimes?
4. In your own life, how is internalizing God's Word both a sweet & sour experience? How is that the case for John here given what he is told to proclaim?
5. Rev 1:3 tells us that the one who "hears & keeps" what is written in this book will be blessed. What will you keep from these chapters? What difference will that make in your life? With whom will you share that this week, even if they won't listen?
