

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Revelation 21:1-7 & 22:1-7, 3:7-13. What strikes you as you read?
2. What do you look forward to most in expectation of the New Creation & fulfillment of God's Kingdom? How might 21:3-5 be the pinnacle of your expectation?
3. In what sense is the Church the "bride" of Christ? (see also Is. 54:5-8; Hos. 2:14-20) What is the significance of a bride prepared for her husband? Why does it matter so much that God chooses to dwell with us to be our God?
4. How is Revelation 22:1-6 similar to the garden of Eden? What is different from the garden of Eden? Why is that important? Compare John 4:13-14 & John 7:37-39 with Rev. 22:1-2. What event stands between the original promises & their being kept that you hold to for hope & assurance?
5. The final arrival of God's kingdom is noted both by what is present AND by what is absent. What do you believe will matter most, that which is present or the absent?
6. Jesus repeatedly says, "I am coming soon." How should this impact the way we live as his disciples? Do you regularly pray with serious intent, "Come Lord Jesus"?
