

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read John 20:19-23 & Acts 2:1-21. What strikes you as you read?
2. In John 20, Jesus grants his Spirit as an antidote to the disciples' fear. How is the Spirit a defense against fear? How is it helping you in our current circumstances?
3. What's important about the disciples proclaiming "the mighty works of God" (v.11)? What does this reveal about the Spirit's agenda? How would you describe the Spirit's work in you? How do you see the Spirit working in your life & in Living Water? What prevents us from seeing God work in the lives of others in our city?
4. How can the Spirit inspire us as we live in this confused & unsettled time? What message do you believe the Spirit would have Peter deliver to the mockers & sceptics in 2022? How are you called to deliver that word from God?
5. John the Baptist promised Jesus would bring the Holy Spirit & fire. Those gifts literally shake the house. What might God want to shake out of or burn out of your life? Why? How has the Spirit changed you lately? Where today do you need the comfort, assurance, guidance or power of the Holy Spirit?
