

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Romans 12:1-21. What here catches your attention? Why?
2. What do you think is the difference between a living sacrifice & a dead one? What is Paul REALLY saying here? Why is that important?
3. How are Christians tempted to 'conform to this world'? Where do you struggle most against that? How successful are you?
4. Why is it important to know what God wants of you? What's the important next step after that? One way to read Romans 12 is to see verses 6-21 as the practical working out of verses 1-5. How does knowing & obeying God's will play into that?
5. Do you think verses 14 - 18 are possible? Why/why not? How does Paul's teaching on how we should treat our enemies challenge your natural response to conflict? Who, in your life, is hard to forgive? What might God be saying about that?
6. Our total devotion to God has radical implications for our relationship with everyone around us, particularly in the body of Christ. Where will you need the community of faith to support you as you grow in grace in these areas? What will you do now?
