1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Isaiah 55:1-11 & 2 Timothy 3:1-17 . What catches your attention? What's important?
2. In what ways do we "spend money on food that does not give strength " & "work for food that does no good"? What's Isaiah's point here? Why is that important?
3. What is the goal of God's invitation here in Isaiah? How is that gift offered throughout the Bible? List as many examples as you can.
4. How are vss 8-9 the turning point in this invitation? How do vss 10-11 lead toward a climax built by vss 1-9? What is the promise of God's word over against the things that don't satisfy but are attractive to human hearts?
5. What is the crucial point Paul makes to Timothy in these verses? Why will everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ be persecuted? What's our response?
6. As you think about the increasing hostility towards Christianity in today's world, why are these words so important for us as they were for Timothy?
7. If the Bible is as important for our lives as we say it is, what will you do to increase your intake of God's Word?
