

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Psalm 147:1-12 & 2 Timothy 4:3-4. What catches your attention in these texts?
2. How would you categorize this Psalm? From what common themes of Jewish faith does the psalmist draw his praise? For what reasons does the Psalmist say we should praise God? How are we supposed to voice our praise of God?
3. How does God taking care of baby ravens (Ps 147:9) illustrate the way He cares for us? Compare this with Lk 12:22-25. What assurance do you find here?
4. How might our "fear of God" be tied to the hope we have in "God's steadfast love"? We usually don't think of fear & hope as companions, but note how God responds: Ps 34:7 - Ps 25:14 - Ps 103:11. Reflect on those verses in light of Ps 147:11.
5. Take a few minutes & note **WHY** the psalmist calls us to praise God in **EACH VERSE** of this psalm? As you read each verse, offer your own prayer of praise & thanks?
6. If you prayed this Psalm in a loud voice every morning for a week, how do you think your attitude to life would change? For a month? With whom can you share your praise of God with this week? Pray for that opportunity.
