1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 21:25-36. What strikes you as you read? What questions come to mind?
2. How alert are you to the dangers, the distractions, & the delusions, which would lead you astray or trip you up as a follower of Jesus? Or do you simply coast along & it's all pretty easy? What are the biggest challenges to your faithfulness?
3. What does it mean in practical terms to be on guard or watch because you do not know when Jesus will return? What sort of anticipation do you hold for that event: afraid? excited? unsure? can't wait? Why?
4. Where do you see God at work in the world today? (please don't say "everywhere") How can you tell? Where is it hard for you to see God at work? Why?
5. How does your family observe Advent? Why is it an important season in the church year or the life of a follower of Jesus?
6. Why does Jesus give the final warning in vss 34-36? Why are "dull" hearts such a danger to followers of Jesus? What is it that dulls your heart & distracts you? What two things does Jesus call us to do to fight against that? Are you?
