2. Why does Luke under the guidance of the Holy Spirit take so much time to give the geographic & historical details surround John's & Jesus' ministries? What does that tell you about the verifiability of his gospel?
3. How does Luke summarize John's message in verse 3? Why would anyone have gone to hear John preach & be baptized by him?
4. How long had it been since there was a prophetic word from God in Israel? What is significant about that long silence being broken at this moment in this way? How would you have felt if you were to hear this sort of message after such a long absence of any message from God? What were the reactions around John?
5. What is the symbolism of the valleys & mountains? What is John preparing the people for according to verse 6? How will the recognize it when they see it?
6. How does John fulfill the words of the angel (Luke 1:16-17) & the prophecy of Zechariah (Luke 1:76-79)?
