

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Mark 12:28-34, Colossians 3:23-24 & 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12. What strikes you as you read? How do these verses all fit together?
2. What makes these 2 commandments (Mk 12) the “greatest”? How do these relate to the 10 Commandments?
3. How was this teacher’s attitude different from others who questioned Jesus? What does that indicate about how we can approach Jesus with our questions?
4. What does this dialogue with Jesus reveal about Jesus & God’s Kingdom? Why does this conversations stop people from challenging Jesus with questions?
5. How do you see Jesus, as “Master,” working through you in your daily tasks? If you aren’t always aware of that, why? As a follower of Jesus, what’s the goal of you serving Jesus by serving your neighbour?
6. Read also 2 Thess 1:3-6. Given that context, suffering, what else do you think Paul should be praying for these disciples? How is what he prays, actually more effective? In your family or small group, pray Paul’s prayer for one another.
