1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Matthew 4:12-22 . What strikes you as you read?
2. How is Jesus a fulfilment of the prophecy Matthew quotes from Isaiah 9? How is he "light" for those in darkness & the shadow of death? How are those 2 conditions still present in people's lives in 2023?
3. Why does Jesus use the same call to repentance that John did? What is the difference between John & Jesus speaking these words? What does Jesus' call mean for us today?
4. How did Jesus call his first disciples? What command & promise did Jesus give them in his calling? What was their response? What can we learn about what it means to be a follower of Jesus? In your answer, did you focus on the command part of the call or the promise? Why? What's the difference between the two?
5. Read on into verses 23-25. What can you conclude about the effective power of the Kingdom to transform lives supernaturally? Be assured, that same effective power is in you by the Holy Spirit. How will you live the Kingdom this week?
