

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Exodus 19:1-9 & 16-20 and 20:1-21 and 31:18. What strikes you as you read?
2. In God's dealing with his people, what comes first: grace or law? How do today's readings lead you toward your answer? Why is "what comes first" so crucial in helping us live deeply into our relationship with God?
3. What is the place of God's law in the Christian life? How is the Old Testament law still relevant for us today?
4. In verses 9-15, what were the people to do in preparation for hearing from God? What limits were given them? Why were these preparations necessary?
5. If you were asked...Could you recite all 10 Commandments? Why might that be a good thing to be able to do? Could you explain Martin Luther's positive & negative keeping of the commandment...not only "you shall not" but "instead you shall"?
6. Jesus summed up the Old Testament law with the two great commands: love God & love your neighbour (Mt 22:36-40). How would you divide the 10 commandments under those two great commands? How do you intentionally work to keep both?
