let's TALK

- 1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read 1 John 1:1-10 & Matthew 5:14-19. What challenges you in the text?
- 2. How does this letter from John build on what he first wrote in the gospel that bears his name? Take time to read John 1 to clarify your thinking .
- 3. What reasons does John give for the authenticity & accuracy of his testimony? Why should we believe what John & the apostles have to say about Jesus Christ?
- 4. The promise of life in Christ isn't just a future eternal life, but has implications for right now. How does the Word of life, Christ in you through baptism & faith, impact your daily life? How would someone know if they met you on the street?
- 5. What does it mean to be the "light of the world"? Considering Mt 5:16, do your good works cause people to give glory to God or you? How do you feel about that?
- 6. Note that Jesus in Mt 5 speaks in the present tense; "you are" NOT "you ought to act like." What difference does that make in how a follower of Jesus lives?
- 7. What are some things that might act as baskets that cover or obscure the light, inhibiting Jesus from shining through you? How can we pray for you there?
