TALK

- 1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Psalm 31:1-5 & Mark 9:14-29. What strikes you as you read?
- 2. From this section of the Psalm, what do you think David expected of God? Why would he have confidence in God to deliver him in this circumstance?
- 3. Why is it important to focus on God's steadfast love through trials? How can this encourage you to "be strong," "take courage," & "wait for the Lord"?
- 4. Describe the scene Jesus encounters. What is the issue for the disciples? What does Jesus say is the real problem? What is Jesus' solution?
- 5. Why didn't the disciples pray? What might they have been doing instead?
- 6. The response of the boy's father in 9:24 seems to be a contradiction. How can you have faith & not have faith? Have you ever felt like this? How are prayer & faith related? In what area of your life do you struggle with doubt? How has God helped you overcome your unbelief in the past?
- 7. Read on to Mark 9:32. The disciples still don't quite understand Jesus. Who do you know who struggles to "get" Jesus? Pray for God's wisdom & the opportunity to share your faith with them.
