Group Bible Study/Discussion:

- 1. Read Psalm 31:1-5 & Mark 9:14-29. What strikes you as you read?
- 2. In this time of hardship, David seems tempted to look at his circumstances & despair. What truth does he confess to refocus himself? What are you tempted to turn to in our overwhelming circumstances? How do you ward off despair?
- 3. Read Luke 23:46 & note the direct quote from Psalm 31:5. Why does Jesus choose this moment to recall that Psalm? How does God respond to this trust & commitment?
- 4. What has happened just before Jesus returns to the larger group of disciples? What sort of "argument" do you think the remaining 9 disciples were having with the religious leaders in Jesus' absence; particularly given what's been asked of them? As the boy's father, how would you feel during this argument?
- 5. In verse 19, Jesus refers to this "unbelieving" or "faithless" generation. In what ways do we see unbelief or faithlessness exhibited in this passage?
- 6. What do you make of Jesus' response to the father in verse 23? Do you believe everything is possible for the one who believes? If not, why not?
- 7. Why couldn't the disciples drive out the evil Spirit? What does Jesus reply reveal about the relationship between the work of the disciples & their relationship to Jesus?
- 8. How does turning to Jesus with questions and doubts demonstrate at least small faith rather than no faith at all? What would no faith look like?
- 9. Pastor John made reference to the saying, "Not all doubts are created equal. Moments of unbelief does not mean disbelief." Does that seem true in your experience? Have you had moments of doubt or unbelief, but never gave up your faith in Jesus?
- 10. Some people allow their doubts or disappointments become unbelief & walk away from a living relationship with Jesus before they've fully trusted in his power to transform their lives. What would you say to someone you know in that circumstance?
- 11. Read Colossians 2:15. Given what you learn of darkness & spiritual warfare in Mark 9, how does Jesus victory on the cross fill you with gratitude & boldness in your relationship with Him?

CHILDREN'S TIME:

BIBLE READING: Mark 9:14-29

¹⁴ When they returned to the other disciples, they saw a large crowd surrounding them, & some teachers of religious law were arguing with them. ¹⁵ When the crowd saw Jesus, they were overwhelmed with awe, & they ran to greet him. ¹⁶ "What is all this arguing about?" Jesus asked.

¹⁷ One of the men in the crowd spoke up, "Teacher, I brought my son so you could heal him. He is possessed by an evil spirit that won't let him talk. ¹⁸ Whenever this spirit seizes him, it throws him violently to the ground. Then he foams at the mouth & grinds his teeth & becomes rigid. So I asked your disciples to cast out the evil spirit, but they couldn't do it."

¹⁹ Jesus said to them, "You unbelieving generation! How long must I be with you? How long must I put up with you? Bring the boy to me."

²⁰ So they brought the boy. But when the evil spirit saw Jesus, it threw the child into a violent convulsion, & he fell to the ground, writhing & foaming at the mouth. ²¹ "How long has this been happening?" Jesus asked the boy's father. He replied, "Since he was a little boy. ²² The spirit often throws him into the fire or into water, trying to kill him. Have mercy on us & help us, if you can." ²³ "What do you mean, 'If I can'?" Jesus asked. "Anything is possible if a person believes." ²⁴ The father instantly cried out, "I do believe, but help me overcome my unbelief!"

- ²⁵ When Jesus saw that the crowd of onlookers was growing, he rebuked the evil spirit. "Listen, you spirit that makes this boy unable to hear & speak," he said. "I command you to come out of this child & never enter him again!"
- ²⁶ Then the spirit screamed & threw the boy into another violent convulsion & left him. The boy appeared to be dead. A murmur ran through the crowd as people said, "He's dead." ²⁷ But Jesus took him by the hand & helped him to his feet, & he stood up.
- ²⁸ Afterward, when Jesus was alone in the house with his disciples, they asked him, "Why couldn't we cast out that evil spirit?" ²⁹ Jesus replied, "This kind can be cast out only by prayer."
