1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read 1 John 2:1-14 & Luke 14:1-14. What strikes you in these texts?
2. Why do you suppose the "sick" man was in such close table fellowship with the "well" religious bigshots? How did Jesus seemingly understand his presence?
3. Why do you think Jesus chose to heal the man on the Sabbath? Jesus puts the Sabbath question back on the Pharisee & the experts of the law. Why do you think they stayed quiet?
4. How does Jesus demonstrate that love is a verb in this moment around a table? What other table will Jesus use to show love to you & all people?
5. How does John say we give evidence of our salvation? (vss 5-6) Compare it with the quote on the other side of this sheet. Are they different or the same thing?
6. What do you think it means to be "living in the light"? How would you know if you were doing so?
7. How is expansive hospitality & excessive generosity such a good sign of God's love in someone's life? What do those character traits say about you?
