TALK

- 1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Mark 9:2-8 & 1 John 2:15-29 . What strikes you as you read?
- 2. Why do you think Jesus was gloriously transfigured at this point in His ministry? How does verse 1 give some insight to what happens here? Read vss 9-10. Why would Jesus tell the disciples to remain silent about this until after His resurrection?
- 3. What is the "cloud" meant to bring to mind for us in this passage? What might Peter's suggestion in v5 regarding putting up three shelters reveal about the way he still perceives Jesus?
- 4. What does John mean by "the world" here? How does his use of the word differ from its use in John 3:16? Where does the world compete for your attention & devotion to the Father? How does the world sometimes win?
- 5. What does John mean by saying, "the last hour is here"? How do people normally think of that moment? How does John's counsel from vs 20 on counteract how Christians often react to any suggestion of "the last" or "end" times?
- 6. What for you is the chief promise in this text? How will you share that this week?
