TALK

- 1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Galatians 1:1-17. What do you notice? Are you familiar with this book? How does that knowledge or lack of it help you here? How?
- 2. How does verse 4 sum up the good news of Jesus? How would you explain that to someone who was not yet a Christian?
- 3. To "be cursed" is strong language. What will Paul not tolerate in the life of the community of Jesus-followers? Why? Why do some Christians base their identity on things other than Christ? Why was it important for the Galatian churches to be reminded that salvation lay in the work of Christ, not in human works?
- 4. What is the difference between finding common ground with people so that you have opportunity to share Christ with them (1 Cor. 9:19-23) & "winning approval from people" (v 10)?
- 5. What are some ways you believe have been changed by your relationship with Jesus Christ? What are some things you pray he continues to transform in you? With whom can you share both the past & on-going work of Christ in your life? How does Paul's sharing his story of transformation encourage you to do the same?
