

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Psalm 8:1-9 & Mark 2:1-12. What strikes you as you read?
2. What would cause David to praise God like this? What might draw you into this sort of praise, worship and exultation? Does that happen often? Why/why not?
3. Read verse 4 again. What do you think caused David to ask this profound question? What answer does he give?
4. Given our human role to serve as God's co-regents in caring for Creation, what are our responsibilities, limits, importance, dignity, and value?
5. Jesus allows himself to be interrupted during his sermon. How might your life be different if you were more open to interruptions such that you were able to demonstrate Christ's work through you?
6. If you were in the man's position, would you rather have heard: "your sins are forgiven" or "take up your mat and go to your home"? Why?
7. Why do you think Jesus intentionally confronts the religious leaders?
8. Who around you needs to have their deepest needs met, their sin forgiven, or their religious selfishness confronted? Pray for the Spirit's power in their life this week.
