TALK

- 1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Psalm 71:14-19 & John 2:13-22. What strikes you as you read?
- 2. How does the picture of an angry Jesus sit with you? What do you think angers Jesus still today? As one of the sellers, how might you have felt?
- 3. Why do the religious leaders challenge Jesus by asking for a "sign" to prove his authority? How is his response, both an answer AND confusing?
- 4. Jesus called us away from a transactional relationship with God & into a personal relationship with him. How does this text highlight the difference between dealing with God via transactions versus living with the Father in a relationship?
- 5. Would you describe your present life circumstances as positive or negative? How are you giving credit & praise to God in the midst of your present circumstances?
- 6. How have previous generations left a lasting testimony for you? What are you doing to leave a lasting testimony for the next generations?
- 7. Describe a time when you experienced God's help. How has God proven himself faithful to your family in both times of difficulty & times of great joy & blessing? How might you share that with someone who does not yet know Jesus?
