An old legend has it that after Jesus called Lazarus to life from his tomb, people would badger Lazarus with questions about what it was like being dead. What did he see? Hear? Feel?

But Lazarus never answered.

According to the legend, Lazarus just laughed.
Like those asking questions of Lazarus,
we know Christ has conquered death,
But we persist: even in our curiosity there is fear.

Because God's children are human beings
—made of flesh & blood—the Son also became flesh & blood.
For only as a human being could he die, & only by dying
could he break the power of the devil,
who had the power of death.

Only in this way could he set free all who have lived their lives as slaves to the fear of dying. - Heb. 2:14-15

whose death we experience tonight.
His death opens for us the great promise:
