TALK

- 1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Galatians 2:16-21. What do you notice? What seems important here? Why?
- Compare the 2 quotes on the front of the Growing Praise. Discuss how both are true. Have you ever believed the gospel is just how we get to "go to heaven when we die"? How did your faith grow beyond that? Is that something you can share with someone who is either still misinformed or not yet a follower of Jesus?
- 3. How is our relationship with God NOT restored? How IS IT restored? How does that second answer become "good news" for all people? Why is that good news?
- 4. How would you explain the difference between being good or moral & being a Christian to someone who thinks being good makes you acceptable to God?
- 5. Though he was a law-keeping Pharisee, why was it only after "dying to the law" that Paul began to live for God? How is that similar to Jesus' in Matthew 16:24-25?
- 6. Is there someone in your life who needs to hear this message? How will you share it with them this week?
