2. What does Paul say baptism does? What is the long term implication of that effect? Why is Gal 3:26-29 so powerful?

 - a. New birth (John 1:12)
 - b. New life (Ephesians 4:22-24)
 - c. New creation (2 Corinthians 5:17)
 - d. New nature (Titus 3:5)
4. What are the resulting benefits and implications of Question #3? How does this describe our access, relationship, & identification with God?
5. How might someone’s relationship with their parents influence their view of our Heavenly Father? How do you feel knowing you are a beloved child of God? How does this affect the way you view yourself? How does this impact the way that you view God?
6. What two things did God send Jesus to accomplish? How might you share that with someone who is not yet viewing God as their Father or Christ as their brother?
