

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Joshua 2. What strikes you as you read?
2. As you read Rahab's story, where are places where you identify with her? her broken past? her knowledge of God's gracious work? her reverent faith? her concern for her family? her obedience?
3. Why do the spies stay with Rahab, well known as a prostitute? What possible advantages does her "profession" afford her? Note the king also trusts her.
4. In Joshua 2:8-13, how many times does Rahab refer to the Lord? How do we know that Rahab didn't simply tell these men what they wanted to hear so they would spare her life?
5. What might make someone afraid of God? If, as Rahab says, the whole nation is terrified of the Israelites because of God's power working for them, why does she feel safe hiding them in her home AND asking for protection when her city falls?
6. Who is someone you know who may be responsive to God working in you like Rahab was to the Israelite spies? Remember to not underestimate God's power.
