let's TALK

- 1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read 2 Kings 22:1-20. What strikes you as you read? What questions come to mind?
- 2. What do we learn about Josiah here that is notable? Quickly trace Josiah's family tree of kings: Manasseh (2 Kings 21:1-6) & Amon (2 Kings 21:19-22). How is Josiah different from his grandfather & his father? To what do you attribute that difference?
- 3. What do you notice about Josiah's instructions in vss 4-7? What's significant about Josiah's administration? How does that characteristic lead to what happens next?
- 4. What could Hilkiah & Shaphan have done with the "book of the Law" when it was found in the Temple if Josiah led a different kind of administration? Do you think the "book of the Law" was 'lost' or 'hidden'? Why do you say that?
- 5. How does the prophetess Huldah factor in to what Josiah does from this point forward? How is the hope she offers from God a driving force in what comes next? How does your hope & assurance in Jesus act in the same way for you? With whom could you share that hope this week?
- 6. What does this text call you to do?
