TALK

- 1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Galatians 6:1-16. What do you notice? What seems important here?
- 2. What's hardest about serving others? Why? What "benefit" makes serving others worth the cost?
- 3. Paul encourages believers (v.1) to gently restore someone caught up in sin. Have you ever tried to do that? How did it go? What does that look like in practice? What are the three dangers connected to someone else's sin or wrong of which we should be mindful? Why are those three things so significant? Why does Paul warn specifically about pride at this point?
- 4. Read John 13:34-35 & compare it to verse 2 & 5:14. If you were to put the "law of Christ" in your own words, how would you say it?
- 5. Why is it important to have Christian friends? Why are non-Christian friends also important? How is your life in Christ enriched by & challenged by each group?
- 6. How can you help a member of your church this week with a particular burden they have? How can your love within the body of Christ be s witness for those outside it?
