1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read John 7:37-52 & 19:38-42. What strikes you as you read?
2. What are some reasons the Bible use the image of thirst to communicate our spiritual need? Read Jer 2:13 & Is 55:1. How do these verses help us understand Jesus here? How is the Spirit's work like water? What evidence would you offer from your life for the work of the Spirit in you?
3. What differences of opinion about Jesus do you hear in today's world? How do you react to those when you encounter them?
4. What tension do you sense between the Temple police/guards & the Jewish leaders? Why is that such an issue here? Why does Nicodemus risk speaking up for Jesus? (See John 3:1-21 for the first recorded encounter between him & Jesus?)
5. Have you ever been ridiculed because of your faith in Jesus? What happened?
6. How does the progressing work of the Spirit in Nicodemus' life encourage you about your own journey in faith AND your faithful witness to others?
7. What does this text call you to do?
