1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Jeremiah 2:1-13 & 19. What strikes you as you read?
2. Read Exodus 20:2-4. Why is "no other gods" the primary commandment? How is this also related to Acts 4:12?
3. What has God done to "deserve" their devotion? What has God done to "deserve" their betrayal?
4. Verse 13 says that God is "the fountain of living water." Why would someone not drink from what is freely offered by God to "quench their thirsts"?
5. What are some "false trusts" or "worthless idols" in our contemporary society? Why do you think the Israelites kept turning back to idols, despite God's warnings?
6. For what are you often tempted to "trade" your relationship with God through Jesus Christ? What attempts to steal your devotion?
7. What can you learn from God's constant love despite Israel's continuous rebellion?
8. How might you share your answer to #7 with someone you know this week who is "thirsty" but trying to drink from a "dry well"?
