

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 6:17-26. What strikes you as you read?
2. Why do you think this encounter with Jesus begins with Jesus healing “everyone?” How is his healing & restorative work linked to what he says here?
3. In this Sermon (& its partner in Matthew 5) Jesus describes the worldview, outlook, or perspective of a disciple in the arms of grace. How is this different from what you encounter in the world? What would a contemporary TV show do to depict the world’s value system over against that of Jesus?
4. Why do you think that Jesus refers to those experiencing poverty, hunger, sadness, & rejection as being “blessed” by God? Why do you think that he refers to those experiencing wealth, comfort, & affirmation as people facing “sorrow”?
5. How does this passage impact your thinking about Jesus? Is there an example to follow or something you need to believe?
6. Describe a time in your life in which you felt like you were depending on God most.
7. What does this text call you to do this week?
