1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 6:27-42. What strikes you as you read?
2. How are the acts of enemies described? How did Jesus tell his disciples to respond? How is the "golden rule" (verse 31) the perfect ideal? How would this sort of behaviour be received in today's world?
3. Does this passage mean we should not seek justice if someone commits a crime against us? Does this suggest Christians are to be the "world's punching bag?" Explain your answers. What encouragement from this passage, & others, to someone who was consumed with bitterness about how they had been poorly treated?
4. How is being generous a blessing to both the giver & the receiver? What blessings does Jesus say generous people will receive?
5. How are vss 37 & 41-42 related? What is the outcome of being this sort of disciple?
6. What is the end result Jesus is hoping to achieve as his followers live like he directs here? What would it mean for you to adopt this lifestyle in obedience to Jesus?
7. What does this text call you to do this week?
