

## TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 10:1-12 & 17-20. What strikes you as you read?
2. What is the significance of our not knowing the names of these other disciples? Why do Luke & the Holy Spirit intentionally keep them anonymous in their obedience & in their success?
3. What do you notice about how Jesus sends his followers? What advantages or disadvantages do you see? How does Jesus provide for those who bear his name & reveal his kingdom to the world? What is the one thing they are told to pray for?
4. How are Jesus' commands about responding to how others receive his followers is helpful? What is our preliminary word to the world? What does the world expect from the church? How is that difference significant?
5. How does Jesus praise these disciples? How does he temper that praise? What is important about that aspect of what Jesus says to them? How would you explain life in Christ, salvation, as a source of true joy to a not-yet-Christian?
6. What does Jesus, through this text, call you to do this week?
