

## TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 9:28-36 & Matthew 5:13-16. What strikes you as you read?
2. Why is it important that the Transfiguration occurs immediately after Peter's confession of Jesus as the Christ, & Christ's call to cross-bearing discipleship?
3. What is the "cloud" meant to bring to mind for us in this passage? What might Peter's suggestion in vs 33 regarding putting up three shelters reveal about the way he still perceives Jesus?
4. What do you think it means to be "salt of the earth," "light of the world," & "a city on a hilltop"? Why does Jesus choose those images to describe those who are his followers? What is the darkest relational sphere in your life currently: family, friendships, work, or neighborhood? How can you bring the brightest light to shine in this darkest area?
5. As a Christian, why would you want to try to fit in with the world when you were born again to stand out? What for you is the chief promise & the chief challenge in these texts? How will you respond?
