1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 9:51:62 & Revelation 7:9-17. What strikes you in these texts?
2. Which coming event at Jerusalem does Luke allude to in verse 51? Why do you think Luke points notably to an event that has not yet happened, as if it has?
3. What do you find significant about Jesus' choice to pass through Samaria?
4. How do the disciples respond to the rejection by the Samaritans? How does Jesus respond to the disciples? What does this tell us about Jesus?
5. What is the significance of the multitude John sees surrounding God's heavenly throne? How are they described by the elders?
6. What is important in these saints having died in difficult circumstances (perhaps persecution) on earth? What does that tell you about their lives? How does God treat those who've fully submitted to him? What do you think that would be like?
7. Compare the destinies of those in Rev 6:16 & 7:17.
8. What for you is the chief promise & the chief challenge in these texts? How will you respond this week?
