

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read John 12:1-11. What strikes you as you read here?
2. If you had a year's wages to spend as you chose; on what you would spend it? Why? If your spouse made that sort of gift to someone without your consent, how would you react? Share a time when you misinterpreted someone's behaviour.
3. How does Judas interpret her act? Do you think he was the only one in the room to feel shocked? How does Jesus' observation about the presence of "the poor" & his impending "absence" heighten the significance of the moment & Mary's gift?
4. What do you believe is on Mary's mind? Are there any distractions or diversions or is she single-minded in her behaviour? What would it take for you to have that sort of Jesus-centred heart? What would you do if you did?
5. How is the priests' reaction to Lazarus an indication of the lengths to which they will go to put an end to the ministry of Jesus? Have you ever seen anything like that?
6. What for you is the chief promise & the chief challenge in these texts? How will you respond this week?
