

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read John 21:1-19 . What strikes you as you read this text?
2. How do you think Peter felt after the resurrection & meeting with Jesus in the house where they had been staying? Why do you think he & some of the others have now travelled back to their home turf in Galilee?
3. Why do you think Peter decides to go fishing? What do you think "fishing" means for Peter & the others? What are the implications of going fishing for them?
4. Why do you think Peter jumps into the water to swim to shore & not wait for the others to row those 100 or so metres?
5. Why is Jesus feeding the disciples when they have a boat-full of fish ready to go?
6. What is Jesus really asking Peter when he asks, "Do you love me more than these?" Why do he repeat the question & the accompanying command? What characterises Jesus's encounter with the disciples throughout this story?
7. What does Jesus teach Peter about where he must look for his identity, meaning, & significance? Why is this so important before he commissions Peter? How do you hear Jesus speaking to you in the way he spoke to Peter here?
