

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 24:1-12 & Colossians 3:1-4. What do you notice? Do you ever tire of this announcement? Why/Why not?
2. How would you answer someone who asked; "Why is Easter such a big deal?"
3. Why do the women go to the tomb? It's the third day...what are they expecting? What is significant about Jesus appearing to the women before he reveals himself risen from the dead to the disciples?
4. Why is it not enough that Christ came, lived as a kind good man, performed miracles, & taught with wisdom? How would you explain to a non-Christian the importance of the resurrection? What impact does Christ's resurrection have on how you face life?
5. Since there were no eyewitnesses to the actual resurrection, what sorts of evidence would you point to as proof of Jesus' being raised from the dead? Why were the male disciples so skeptical & then so un-believing?
6. How does the reality of the Resurrection give you confidence in God's plan for humanity? ...in God's plans for you? How can we encourage one another to maintain hope & trust in God's plans, especially during times of difficulty & uncertainty?
