

## let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 19:28-48 & Luke 20:1-8. What strikes you as you read this account?
2. What would some of the Jerusalem dwellers & Passover pilgrims have been expecting as Jesus' disciples & other followers started singing & hailing Jesus as king? What sort of issues would that have likely caused in Jerusalem?
3. Why would the religious leaders want Jesus to have a more low-key profile? What does Jesus' response to them say about his authority versus theirs? Why is that a significant detail in the narrative?
4. What is notable about Jesus weeping over Jerusalem? What does that imply about the real nature of his grief at that moment? (Think BIG)
5. What about Jesus has convinced you he is worthy of praise? Why is it that, when shown the same evidence, some people accept Jesus as King & others persist in rejecting him? What are the consequences of this rejection? What is your role when someone a) doesn't yet know the gospel & b) when someone rejects it?
6. If Jesus rode into Wagga to announce the arrival of his rule over all things in love, what would be the most common reception he would receive? Why do you think that is so? Who would be the most antagonistic? Who would be most joyful?
7. For whom do you weep because they stand outside the embrace of Jesus' saving love? How do you relate to them such that they experience that love in you?
