Where in your life are you most tempted to build on something other than Jesus (comfort, control, approval, etc.)?
- 5. What does 1 Peter 2:6 say about those who trust in Jesus? How does that impact your view of God?
- 6. If Jesus really is the living stone who secures & gives you life, what fears or anxieties can you surrender to Him right now?
- 7. As we study God's word here, what are you motivated by the Spirit to do?
