1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read John 1:1-18 & Romans 1:20-23 & 28-32. What strikes you as you read?
2. Why would someone reject the idea of God's existence? What could someone choose as their "devotion" rather than the Living God? What is the end result of such misguided or misdirected "devotion," "worship," & allegiance?
3. Where else do we read "in the beginning"? What sticks out to you about the way John speaks of Jesus? How is this different from how today's world views him?
4. John says Jesus is "full of grace & truth." What makes grace AND truth both essential in the life of a follower of Jesus?
5. How is the majesty & beauty of Creation a sign of God's presence & power? How would you use Creation as evidence if someone said to you there is no God?
6. How does the "depravity" or brokenness of the world give evidence of our rebellion against God? Read Romans 3:21-26 as God's ultimate answer.
7. What is the greatest challenge for you in these texts? What do they call you to do? Where & with whom will you practice that this week?
