4. Why is it essential that the water of life be "without cost"? How is that a healing comforting reminder when your life hurts?
5. Why is it important to focus on God's steadfast love through trials? How can this encourage us to "be strong," "take courage," & "wait for the Lord"?
6. How does a confession of faith give one conviction & commitment to know God more, submit to & rely on Him? Our lives & destiny are in God's righteous, loving & sovereign plan. So, what is the most encouraging aspect of these verses for you?
7. As we study God's word here, what are you motivated by the Spirit to do?
